- We will remember that investing in our process of birthing and cultivating is not just about
 the tools and frameworks we produce, but about developing a model of collaboration that
 offers an alternative way to develop solutions to systemic problems.
- We will press into the tension we may feel in finding the balance between birthing tools and frameworks that are radical & revolutionary as well as practical & applicable.
- We will trust ourselves and each other to birth these tools. We will remember that all of us have nurtured, drafted, designed and developed many times in many contexts and we can tap into our wisdom and experience.
